Looking for Volunteers

Become more involved with Neighbor to Neighbor (N2N)

Neighbor to Neighbor (N2N), a 501c (3) not-for-profit organization, is a community based volunteer organization that helps our Pound Ridge Seniors and disabled in time of need. Neighbor to Neighbor (N2N) works in conjunction with the Town's Recreation Department and the Town's Police Department. Services such as grocery shopping assistance, meals on wheels, RUOK calls and medical equipment loans are coordinated as well as volunteer rides to medical appointments.

Committed volunteers are needed in the following areas:

Neighbor to Neighbor (N2N) Board of Directors

The Board of Directors would meet four times a year to discuss issues with ongoing services, new services that may be needed and make decisions on financial matters. Monies that are donated to Neighbor to Neighbor are used for various projects to assist seniors in Pound Ridge. The Board of Directors will review proposals for funding that the Senior Advisory Council submits. We are looking for new members for the Board of Directors.

Senior Advisory Council

We would like to put in place a group of seniors (62+) who are active in our programs to help guide and direct the programs we offer. This group would meet once a month to review the programs that have taken place and advise on new programs needed. The Council would formulate proposals to be presented to the Board of Directors for use of N2N funds. Join us if you would like to be more involved in planning trips, seminars and services that Pound Ridge Seniors would like.

Additional volunteer opportunities are available in the following areas:

- Provide rides to Medical Appointments for Seniors
- Deliver groceries or meals to homebound seniors
- Assist with setup and serving at the Neighbor to Neighbor luncheons (5 a year)

Expired Prescription Medication Collection

The Pound Ridge Police Department is now a collection site for expired prescription medications. Items can be dropped off in the secure container in the police department lobby

Monday to Friday 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.

This program keeps the drugs out of the hands of potential illicit users and helps the environment by keeping these chemicals out of the ground water by not flushing them (which is commonly done).

There is no cost for this service. Any questions can be directed to the Pound Ridge Police

Department at (914) 764-4206.

This program is coordinated and funded through the Westchester County STOP DWI program. Once full, the containers contents are removed and destroyed by the Drug enforcement Administration at no cost to the municipality.
