Bottles and Cans (returnables)

The Market

55 Westchester Ave, Pound Ridge, NY 10576

Returnable bottles and cans are collected at The Market.

Bring non-returnables to the town's Recycling Center on Stone Hill Rd.

Clothing, Shoes, Curtains, Fabric, Belts, and Leather

Pehind the Firehouse

80 Westchester Ave, Pound Ridge, NY 10576

Look for a bin located in front of the pond. Drop off all clothing items including shoes, boots, sneakers, and handbags as well as household items such as fabrics, curtains, sheets, and blankets.

Dental Hygiene Packaging

Pound Ridge Cosmetic Dentistry

A drop-off box is located in the waiting room for toothbrushes, toothpaste containers, and floss containers. Items will be processed with a first-of-its-kind recycling platform by TerraCycle.

Electronic Waste

(computers, televisions, VCRs, DVD players, gaming consoles, cords, monitors, computer mice, etc.)

Eyeglasses

Flag Retirement

Bring faded and frayed American flags to the bin behind the receptionist at the Town House. Boy Scout Troop #1 will properly retire "Old Glory".

Food Scraps

Residents can dispose of organic food waste in the bins Wed. and Sat. 8am to noon.

Motor Oil, Tires, and Car Batteries

Sunoco Gas Station

By law, any service establishment that sells at least 500 gallons per year of new oil and performance vehicle servicing must accept from the public, at no charge, up to 5 gallons of used oil per person per day. Additionally, NYS requires (1) a \$5 deposit on all car batteries at the point of purchase. When your battery needs replacing, return it for a refund. (2) Customers may return tires in the same size and in a quantity equal to the number of new tires purchased or installed.

Mascara Wands for Wildlife

Henry Morgenthau Preserve

80 Pound Ridge Road, Pound Ridge, NY 10576

First soak the wand in warm water to remove residual mascara. Bring the clean wand to the trailhead kiosk at the Henry Morgenthau Preserve. Used wands are helpful for cleaning the fur and feathers of wild animals at a wildlife sanctuary.

Prescription Medicines

Drop items off at the Police Department; all privacy is protected.

Razors and Razor Blades

Philip's Men's Hair Design

70 Westchester Ave # 3, Pound Ridge, NY 10576

Drop off disposable razors and blades at Philip's Men's Hair Design in Pound Ridge. When the box is full it will be shipped to TerraCycle and processed with one of its first-of-its-kind recycling platforms.
