Adoption of Minutes from the Meeting of July 25, 2019

Splinter Construction, Inc. (Nast) - Contract Vendee, Joan O'Brien - Owner, Lower Shad Road, Block 9318, Lot 45.2. Application for Residential Site Plan review to construct a new three-bedroom single family residence, new gravel driveway, new on-site septic system, a new drilled well, and a new stormwater treatment system. The property is located in an R-3A zoning district and consists of 11.9 acres. Water Control Commission approval was granted on April 10, 2019, conditioned on a Conservation Easement Agreement. ZBA approval was granted on August 21, 2019 for the required 250' horizontal circle.

Jonathan Stein, 128 Kitchawan Road, Block 10264, Lot 1.2. Application for Residential Site Plan Review to install a floating dock, ramp and deck with gravel access, movable boat rack and stepping stones path, that exceeds the maximum building and lot coverage thresholds for an R-3A zoning district. The property consists of 4.565 acres. Water Control approval was granted on September 4, 2019.

Recommendation to the Town Board for release of the outstanding bonds referred to in the Resolution of Final Subdivision Approval by the Planning Board dated September 26, 2002 for the DelSavio/Knob Hill Application:

- \$5,750 bond, reduced from \$30,000, for erosion control
