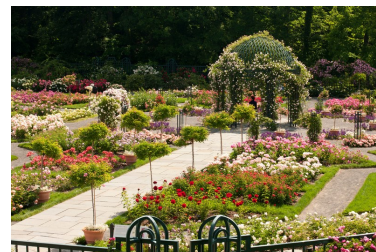

Saturday Night Fever

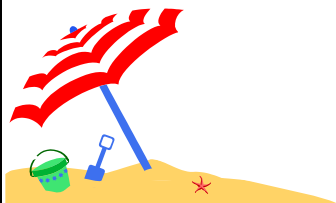
