PARK FACILITIES

Welcome to the Town of Pound Ridge Parks and Facilities. Our Parks offer something for everyone young and young at - heart. Check out our amenities, as many are available for public rental for all types of occasions. Pound Ridge Park has two full court basketball courts as well as a full size beach volleyball court, and Gaga Pitt. There also are four tennis courts which require a permit for use. You can bring your children and play on the two play-grounds, use the walking trails or just come by on a warm summer night and catch a Little League baseball game, a movie or a concert. Also in the summer with paid admission, you can enjoy the three pools that are at the heart of our park. Enjoy your Sundays with live music by the pool. During the months of June and July, we welcome you and your family to enjoy our free "Movies in the Park". We also invite you to pay a visit to our passive recreational facility Sachs Park located at 4 Old Stone Hill Road.

CONANT HALL

CONANT HALL

Built in 1893 by the Pound Ridge Presbyterians and sold to the Community Church in 1949, then gifted to the Town of Pound Ridge in 1983. This grand old building has been the venue for many wonderful weddings, fairs, parties, classes and more. Conant Hall (located at 257 Westchester Ave.) is maintained by the Pound Ridge Maintenance Department staff with scheduling of the Hall space performed by the Recreation and Parks Department. The Hall holds a maximum capacity of 195 people (both rooms combined) with tables and chairs included (approx. 10 tables and 60 chairs) Available to Residents and non-Residents with a completed facility use application and insurance.

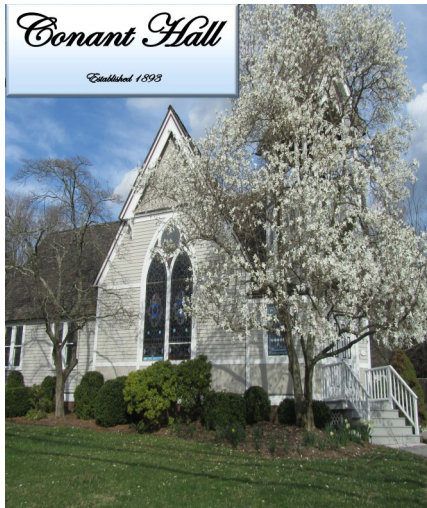
