



- Promote greater transparency from the wireless industry by requiring applicants to demonstrate radio frequency compliance with FCC standards.
- Address small wireless facility buildout standards.
- Encourage continued use of public assets to allow greater community control over placement, design and long-term site maintenance.




# NWC Coverage Map For A Single Provider

- High frequency coverage map
- Assumes same provider at each site
- Level of propagation signal strength is shown through the gradation of colors from yellow to blue or no color
  - → Yellow superior; strong enough to operate within most buildings
  - → Green average; strong enough to operate in vehicle but not inside most buildings
  - →Blue acceptable; strong enough to operate outside but not in most vehicles or buildings
  - No color poor; no service or dropped calls; gaps where new sites will be needed









Macro Cell Sites Potentially On Publicly Owned Property

# Additional Recommendations



Amend Section 133-58.1 of the Town Code from 1988 to make current with 5G deployment practices and Federal Regulations. Pinpoint specific locations and acceptable infrastructure design for each suggested facility.

Communicate with utility pole owner(s) to ascertain willingness to allow small cells on their poles.

If yes, share design objectives

Prepare standard lease agreements for community owned property with preapproved terms. Meet with wireless and fiber providers to present goals for improving wireless coverage. Verify and map local fiber services and discuss availability for expansion, especially for wireless infrastructure. Consider fiber to underserved areas at the Town's expense with the goal of obtaining dark or lit fiber leasing revenue.

The Recreation Department is interested in adding onto the Pound Ridge Business Association's (PRBA) already amazing Halloween celebration in Town. Our request for window painting and a ScareCrow Contest will enable families to embrace the Halloween spirit beginning the holiday a little earlier this year, building excitement through Halloween.

In our discussions with Chair Lisa Miller, the PRBA fully supports our idea to offer children the opportunity to decorate storefront windows within the Scotts Corners Business District on Saturday, October 21. Dear Kevin and Members of the Town Board,

Earlier this year, we were awarded \$15,000 from NY State Energy Research & Development Agency. The grant was earmarked \$4,600 for an energy audit, and the remaining \$10,400 is for upgrades to the Town House. The Energy Audit was done in May. The attached Clean Energy Communities Energy Study is very thorough report of the Energy Audit. It evaluates our current energy use and costs and provides a list of recommendations to make our Town House more energy efficient. The report also includes estimates on the savings and cost involved with those recommendations.

We recommend using the remaining the \$10,400 for all the items listed as "R"- "Recommended: Energy saved with a reasonable payback (within measure life)" on pages 4 and 5. The charts on pages 4 and 5 include the reduction in greenhouse gas emissions, total annual savings, estimated install costs and simple payback in years.

- 1. Interior Lighting Retrofit: Install new lamps with LED equivalents
  - a. NYSEG Direct Installation Program if needed
- 2. Exterior Lighting Retrofit: replace exterior lamps with LED equivalents
- 3. Improve Temperature Control: Install WI Fi enabled thermostats so we can control each zone when occupied and separate settings at night.
- 4. Insulate Heating and Domestic Hot Water Pipes from the existing boiler
- 5. Install Motor Controls: a control mechanism can disengage the pump when the loop or thermostat temperatures are satisfied.
- 6. Install a Tankless Water Heater: an on demand electric water heater that is sized to serve the hot water load of the Town House

The complete description for each existing situation, measure and recommendation are on the pages following the charts on pages 4 and 5.
